




YOUNG POWER VOL. 2

STUDY VISIT

3 – 8 April 2022 Kutaisi, Georgia



Description, aims and objectives

Project YOUng Power is focused on improving the conditions for social entrepreneurship in 6 countries - Slovakia, Czech Republic, Poland, Hungary, Armenia and Georgia.

This study visit aims to facilitate experience exchange among Georgia, V4 countries, and Armenia and highlight Georgia's successful examples of social entrepreneurship. Participants will visit 8 social entrepreneurship projects in and around Kutaisi to learn about and discuss their mission, strategy, implementation, processes and how they produce impact on the communities. They will also meet with local policymakers to talk about their approach to facilitating and enhancing social entrepreneurship in the region.

The exact schedule is currently being finalised and will be provided later.

Participant's profile

Participants must:

- Speak English fluently
- Be fully vaccinated (given Georgia's travelrelated restrictions)
- Be either young leaders, youth workers, young entrepreneurs or public sector workers
- Be interested in social entrepreneurship

The study visit is open for 20 people from 6 countries, aged 18-35 (4 from the Czech Republic and Hungary, 3 from Slovakia, Poland, Georgia and Armenia).

Kutaisi International Airport is located near Kutaisi and is serviced mainly by the Wizz Air that offers direct flights from Vienna, Budapest, Prague, Gdansk, Katowice, Kraków, Warsaw (Chopin) and Wroclaw.

Travel options + travel costs

Travel costs and costs for COVID-19 testing (if necessary) will be reimbursed after the study visit .

Maximum budget:

Slovakia - 300€ per person

Hungary - 300€ per person

Poland - 300€ per person

Czechia - 300€ per person

Georgia - 30€ per person

Armenia - 200€ per person

(The itinerary must be approved before the purchase of tickets)

Lodging + food

Accommodation will be specified later.

There will be breakfast, lunch and dinner plus coffee breaks twice a day – the provided food will respects the participants' food intolerances and special dietary requirements.

COVID-19

All participants have to be fully vaccinated (given Georgia's travel-related restrictions) and wearing a face mask/FFP2 respirator (to be specified later) will be compulsory. Georgia accepts all double-and single-dose vaccines.

More information will be provided later on, given the volatile nature of the situation.
